The Pan American Games Torch Relay and The Luminous Veil celebrations (www.toronto2015.org/torch-relay), in conjunction with the Thrill of The Grill (www.thedanforth.ca), are scheduled to happen on July 4, 2015. Starting at 5pm, it will be an evening filled with live music, food, the arrival of the Pan Am Games torch, as well as a special presentation highlighting the Luminous Veil. Residents are encouraged to come out and enjoy this memorable occasion.

ROAD CLOSURE DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Prince Edward Viaduct (Bloor Street Viaduct) - Closed between Parliament St. and Broadview Ave.

- **NO ACCESS to Castle Frank Road or Bloor Street East VIA:**
 - Don Valley Parkway – north and south
 - Bayview Ave. – north and south
 - Broadview Ave.
 - MacKenzie Rd.
 - Drumsnab Rd.
 - Dale Ave.
 - Cambridge Ave.
- **Special access will be given to residents on Castle Frank Cres.; two-way access and egress at Parliament St. ONLY.**
- Access will be granted to TTC buses, 94 Wellesley and 65 Parliament, between Parliament St. and Castle Frank Station – access and egress at Parliament St. ONLY.
- TTC Bloor-Danforth Night Bus will be unaffected; bus access will be controlled across the Bloor St. Viaduct nightly between 2am and 7am.

People interested in attending this event are encouraged to use the TTC. Transit riders can use Castle Frank or Broadview stations; both provide easy access to the event.
