Our production vehicles and various pieces of film equipment will be located on:

- North side of Danforth between Chester Ave & Ellerbeck St
- South side of Hurndale Ave between Jackman Ave & Playter Blvd
- West side of Jackman Ave between Danforth Ave & Hurndale Ave
- East / West side of Hampton Ave between Garnock Ave and Danforth Ave

We will begin reserving the above areas with cones on November 5th at 7am, with vehicles arriving shortly after at approximately 7:30am, **departing by 5pm on November 7th**

Production will remain on a small portion of Danforth Ave (between Playter Ave and Jackman Ave), as well as Jackman Ave until 5pm on November 7th

Displaced permit parkers affected by our filming activities are kindly asked to park in their driveways (if applicable), surrounding streets, nearby pay lots. On our filming day, please contact Matty Alex, Assistant Locations Manager, 416-460-0887 from the Locations Department. We will direct you to available parking and/or reimburse your parking receipt.

All of our filming & related activities are undertaken under the authority & approval of the City of Toronto Film, Television and Digital Media Office. ANY INTERMITTENT TRAFFIC STOPPAGES/CONTROL will be conducted under the safe supervision of the Toronto Police Service.
